

## A SPECIAL MESSAGE FROM THE COMMISSIONER OF SOCIAL SECURITY

A new law provides Medicare Part A (hospital insurance) to people of any age who have been exposed to health hazards in the public health emergency declaration area of Libby and Troy, Montana.

Medicare Part A helps cover inpatient care in hospitals, skilled nursing facilities, some home health care, and hospice care. People with Medicare Part A may also enroll in Medicare Part B (medical insurance) which covers doctors' services, outpatient care, home health care, and some preventive services. Medicare Part B has a premium; however, depending on your family's income, you may be eligible for additional assistance through the Medicare Saving Programs with your state. People with Medicare may also get prescription drug coverage, and we may be able to provide *Extra Help* with prescription drug coverage costs. We can discuss your options while you are applying for the program.

To get this coverage you should contact us as soon as possible. You must file an application, meet certain residence requirements, and must have been diagnosed with an asbestos-related disease.
