



## Create Your Personal *my* Social Security Account Today

### If you do not receive benefits, you can:

- Request a replacement Social Security card if you meet certain requirements
- Check the status of your application or appeal
- Get your *Social Security Statement* to:
  - View estimates of your future benefits;
  - Verify your earnings; and
  - View the estimated Social Security and Medicare taxes you've paid
- View retirement benefit estimates at different ages or dates when you want to start receiving benefits
- View possible spouse's benefits
- Get a letter proving you don't receive benefits



### If you receive benefits or have Medicare, you can:

- Request a replacement Social Security card if you meet certain requirements
- Report your wages if you work and receive Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) benefits and/or Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payments
- Get your benefit verification letter
- Check your benefit and payment information
- Update your contact information
- Start or change direct deposit of your benefit payment (Social Security beneficiaries only)
- Request a replacement Medicare card
- Get a replacement SSA-1099/1042S tax form for any of the past six years in which benefits were paid
- Complete some forms online, including the Medical Continuing Disability Review Report (SSA-454) without having to mail them to us
