OASDI Beneficiaries by State 2014




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
1. From the SSA Open Government Map Gallery landing page – Click the map image with your mouse to open the map application.




2. From the main map application page – the left panel contains descriptive information on the OASDI Beneficiaries Information by State and contact information & links for more information.



3. From the Layers Tab – the OASDI layers can be checked or unchecked to show or remove the layer. Multiple layers can be on at the same time, however only the top layer checked will be displayed.



4. From the Legend Tab – the OASDI layers legends is viewable. It shows the color spectrum and values cohort for each layer.



5. From the map section of the application, click on any State to open the data dialogue box with OASDI information for that state. If multiple layers are selected, use the right arrow key on the box to see data for other layers. When finished viewing click the X in the top right corner to close the dialogue box.
