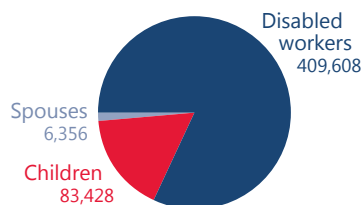
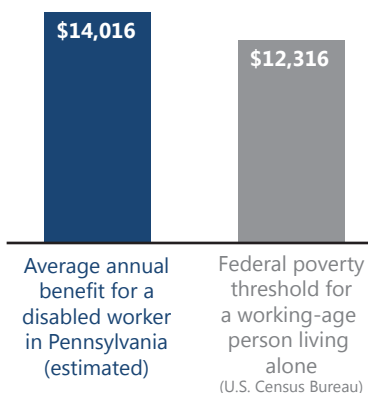




Most DI beneficiaries in Pennsylvania are disabled workers
