B: Living in the household of another. Includes aged and blind recipients residing in a federal Code B living arrangement.

C: Domiciliary care. Includes aged and blind recipients certified by the state as residents of a private nonmedical facility or a residential facility serving 16 or fewer persons that provides personal care and services, and who are unrelated to the proprietor.
