DEFINITIONS:

D: Domiciliary care. Includes recipients certified by the state as residents of a licensed nonmedical facility that provides room, board, and supervision.

E: Personal care facility. Includes recipients certified by the state as residents of a licensed nonmedical facility that provides general supervision, physical care, and assistance in carrying out the basic activities of daily living.

F: Home for the aged. Includes recipients certified by the state as residents of a nonmedical facility for the aged.

I: Medicaid facility. Includes recipients residing in a federal Code D living arrangement.

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
